Was kann der Comic für den Unterricht leisten? Heinrich Ammerer, Markus Oppolzer.2022-11-10 Der vorliegende Sammelband fokussiert das Verhältnis verschiedener Unterrichtsfächer zum Einsatz von Comics in der Sekundarstufe. Nach einer theoretischen Rahmensetzung in drei Überblicksbeiträgen bieten die fachspezifischen Kapitel eine generelle Einschätzung des didaktischen Potentials dieser Erzählform. Im Vordergrund stehen unterschiedliche methodische Zugänge für einen kompetenzorientierten Unterricht, die Behandlung zentraler fachtypischer Problemstellungen, aber auch ein konkretes Anwendungsbeispiel. The introduction provides information on the criteria for inclusion, central sources, theoretical frameworks, and the spectrum of the media associations investigated. Part I assembles three overview articles on the media of radio, film and theater for children and young people as well as a contribution on the conception and development of the online portal.
